National Highways Limited (Company No.09346363) (a) in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and (2) and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(b), hereby makes the following Order on Garstang New Road, in the County of Lancashire:

1. This Order may be cited as The Mains Lane (Shard Road to Singleton Junction) (30 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2024 and shall come into force on 8th June 2024.

2. Subject as mentioned in articles 3 and 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the following sections of Mains Lane (formerly part of the A585 Trunk Road).

- a) The eastbound and westbound carriageways, from a point 13 metres east of its junction with A588 Shard Road to its junction with Pool Foot Lane (Singleton Junction), a total distance of 1500 metres.

3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority, or ambulance service.

4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special-Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 (a).

5. This Order hereby revokes any and all other existing speed limit orders affecting these lengths of carriageway.
