Thanks for the info you've provided, it's really helpful. We're just working through the mechanics of who needs to be told and in what order, and building this into a revised comms plan. We will keep you looped into this. As things stand we anticipate contacting MPs and MSs to set up briefing opportunities in [when?? the next few weeks??] with a view to holding these [when? early – mid May?]. These will be high level briefings, to be supplemented with more detail as we get closer to the works. As things stand the work is being planned for mid July onwards, although this date is not in the public domain yet. We recognise that landing these messages will need some care and attention though, so we're spending some time establishing a thorough comms and engagement plan.

NB If you need my help in working through the comms planning piece, please do draw me into that.


