Good afternoon [REDACTED]

As promised please find below a list of the major events that are due to take place in June 2024 in the Principality Stadium which Welsh Government would be classifying as a significant event where attendance is likely to be circa 50,000 plus and thus we will be placing restrictions on our contractors on working these nights to minimise disruption and delays. I have also included the major events planned from July to October 2024 as these will also be impacted albeit through the main Bridge deck works as opposed to the advanced preparatory works you are looking to undertake in June 2024. These are significant events for "Wales PLC" and as such I would be grateful if you could do your best to avoid causing disruption to fans travelling to and from the stadium on these dates.

There are other events that are being held both in Chepstow Racecourse and in the Cardiff City football Stadium which whilst will attract a lesser number of attendance are still significant events that could potentially cause issues and delays for the travelling public and venues which we obviously want to avoid. You have advised at the co-ordination meetings that you are engaging with venues such as these in this respect which is great.

You may or may not be aware that Welsh Government also place restrictions on the motorway and trunk road network in Wales where we look to minimise or avoid undertaking works due to the higher traffic flows and the significant disruption this will cause. Based on the dates you have previously advised for the works (June to October 2024) I have also provided details of these restrictions below for your information :-

***Full Embargo period definition** . Avoid all works, including Night works that impinge on the running carriageway. Emergency works are permitted but timings should be considered in terms of traffic sensitivity to minimise disruption where possible.

****Restricted Period** - Night works will usually be permitted during this period.. Where possible, planned works should be programmed to avoid daytime restrictions on the running carriageway on all routes. Emergency works are permitted but timings should be considered in terms of traffic sensitivity to minimise disruption where possible.
